By utilizing our resources, relationships, and our American and Haitian staff, we strive to create a **CIRCLE OF CARE** around each child with the intent of giving every boy and girl the chance to reach their God-given potential.

Second, we will utilize our platform to help create sustainable and dignified jobs to push against the poverty-driven child abandonment and child slavery cycles. We believe the best orphan care strategy starts with a fight to keep families together.

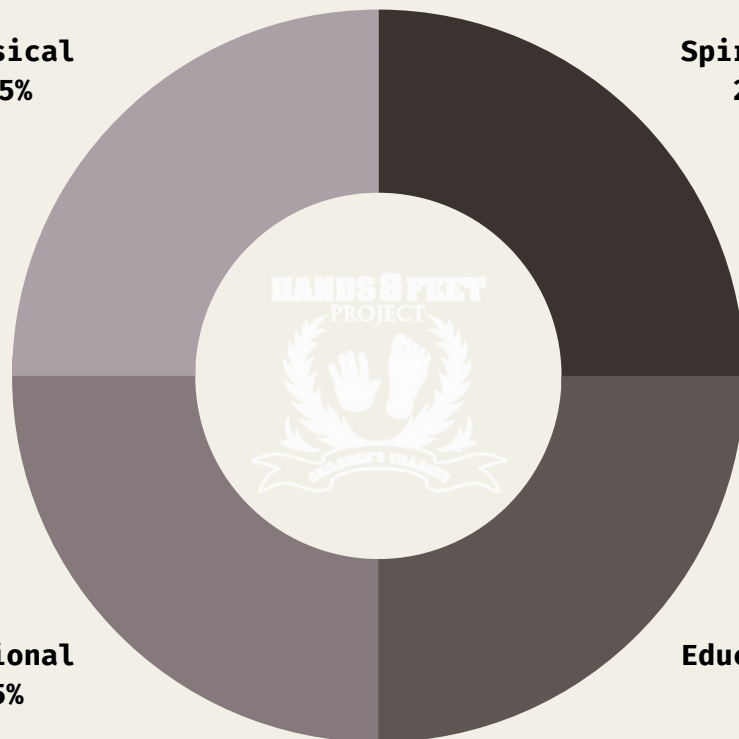
Circle of Care

Physical needs are met through: regular medical visits, proper nutrition, and basic needs (clothing, safe housing).

Emotional needs are met through: mental health specialists who equip children with helpful tools for well-being and are available 24/7 for children under our care. Additionally, Hands and Feet Project partners with a team of highly skilled individuals who have helped create a training curriculum for our staff.

In fact, we had **no reported COVID-19 cases among staff, children, and family in Haiti in 2020.**
